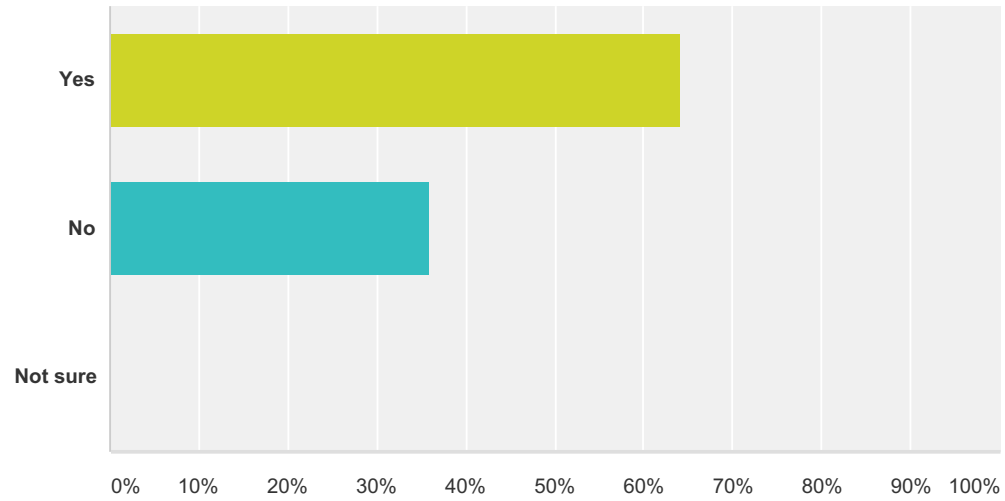


Q1 Do you live in the Town of DeWitt and/or pay taxes to the JD School District?

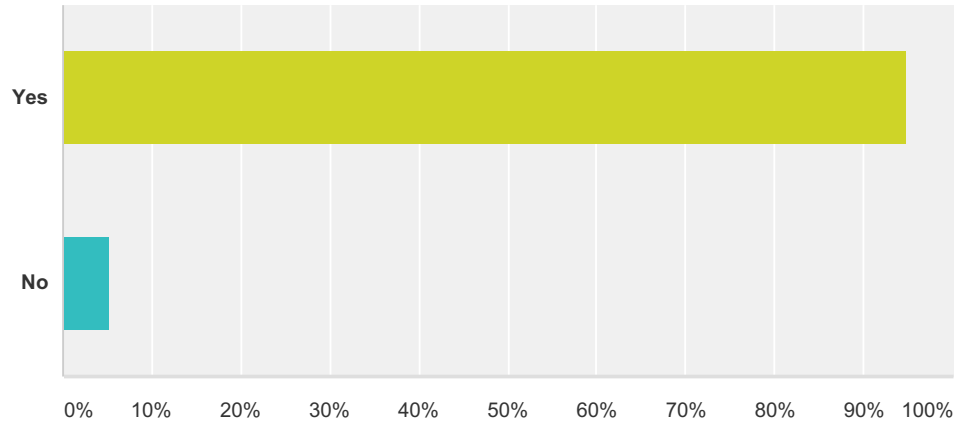

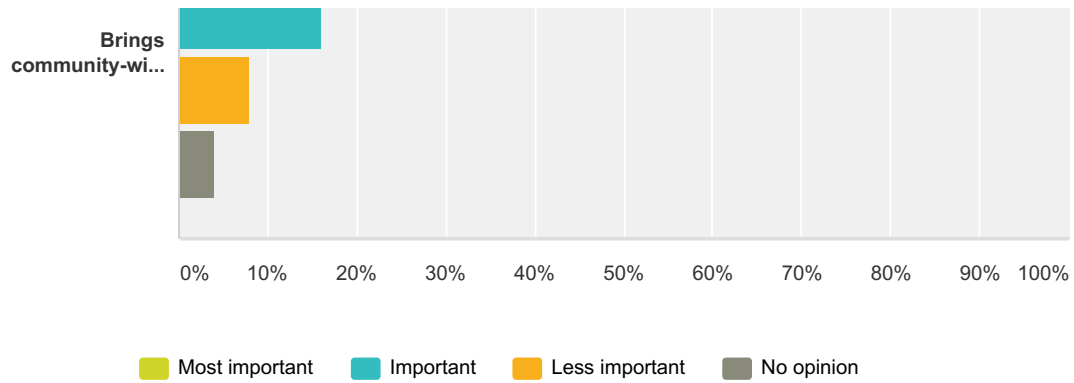

Q5 Here are some features that residents have told us are important in a new library space. What's important to you? Please rank each item.

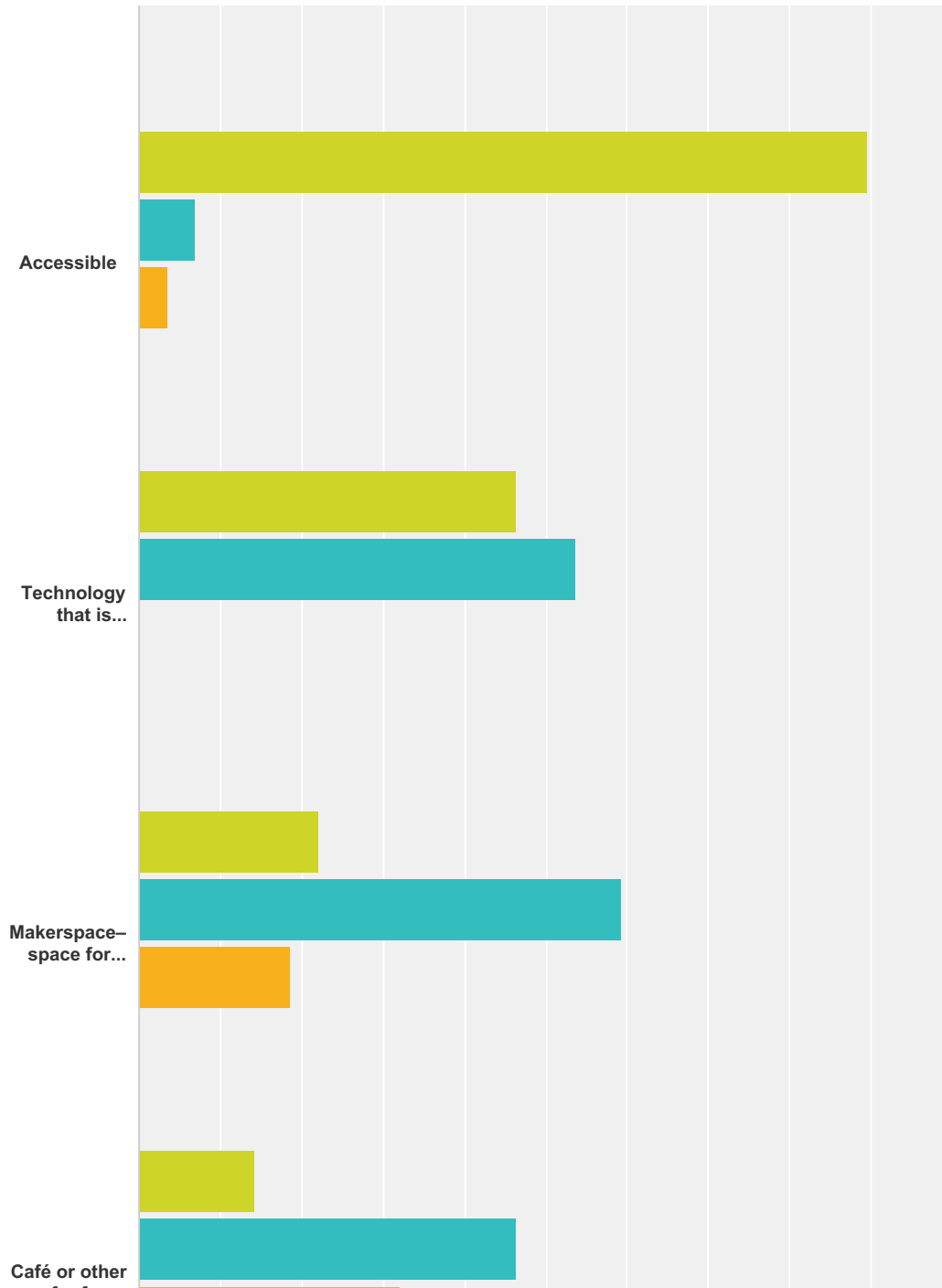

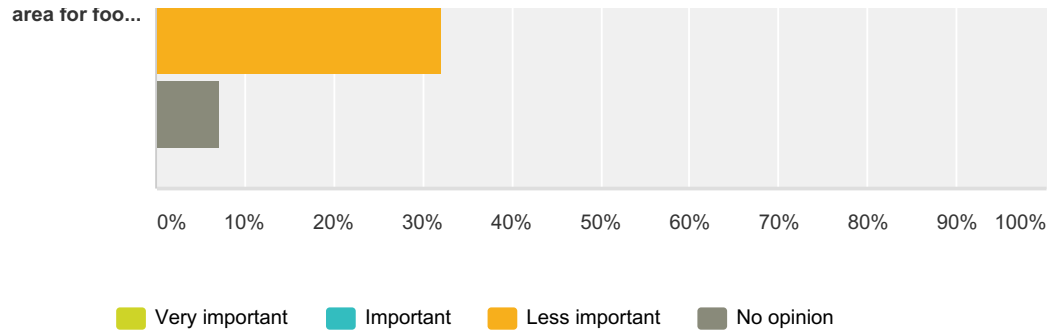
