Easy Readers (*aka Readers*) are books for children who are beginning to read on their own.

Publishers of Readers generally publish these types of books in difficulty levels from pre-reader to level 4 or 5. However, since publishers each follow their own numbering systems, levels are not consistent from company to company .

To simplify the search for books that are right for your child, the Library has condensed Reader levels to just 1, 2, and 3. Each Reader has been carefully analyzed by your librarian to determine which level is the most suitable.

Book covers have been labeled with colored dots—yellow, orange, or green—in the lower left corner to help you locate each level more easily.

Here's the Library's general definition of each level:



**Level 1:** few words, simple concepts, mostly pictures

**Level 2:** more complex plots, fewer pictures, 3-7 sentences per page

**Level 3:** richer vocabulary, fewer or no pictures, beginning chapters

If you'd like to know what level the publisher labeled the book, you can usually find it on the front cover, either in the top left or top right corner.

Check the back cover for the publisher's definition of the level. Here are two back cover examples from two different publishers. Again, each publisher follows its own system, thus definitions will vary.



Readers offer a wide variety of fictional stories, many of which feature characters from popular children's television series, movies, and books, including *Elephant & Piggie*, *Dr. Seuss*, *Fancy Nancy*, *Marvel*, *Star Wars*, and *Disney*, to name just a few.

Nonfiction topics are covered in Readers, too, such as animals, plants, habitats, famous people, and historical places.

Your Library has hundreds of Readers from which to choose. Here are several titles, listed by Library designated levels (*Note: Library levels will not always match the Publisher's levels*):




