The Library's Rokus let you access streaming video services that the Library subscribes to for your education, entertainment, and enjoyment.

These devices are so easy and simple to use, it is no wonder people are using them instead of cable subscriptions.

1. Connect the power cord to the Roku and plug the other end into an outlet.
2. Connect the Roku to your TV.
3. Turn on your TV and use your TV remote to select the proper input source.
4. Log into your home Wi-Fi internet connection.
5. Access the services you are interested in.


Step-by-Step Guide

Instructions:

1. Connect the power cord to the Roku and plug the other end into an outlet:



2. Connect the Roku to your TV:




- ◆ Connect the HDMI cable from the Roku to your TV. If your TV has no HDMI port, plug in and use the HDMI to AV adapter.

3. Turn on your TV and use your TV remote to select the proper input source:

- ◆ E.g., If you plugged the HDMI cord into the HDMI 1 port on your TV, the correct input source will be HDMI 1.

4. Log into your home Wi-Fi internet connection:

- ◆ From the Roku home screen, press the left arrow on the Roku remote and select Settings, then Network, then Set up connection, then Wireless.
- ◆ Choose your home network, enter your password, and select Connect.



5. Access the services you are interested in:

- ◆ Press the Home button on the Roku remote to return to the home screen.
- ◆ Select the service you wish to view. The Roku has Netflix and Disney+ subscriptions.

- ◆ A high speed internet connection is required for the Roku to function properly.
- ◆ Other than your home Wi-Fi password, **do not enter** any of your personal account information into any of the channels, as it **will not be cleared** when you return it.
- ◆ Do not add or remove any channels. The library provides **Netflix and Disney+ subscriptions**; the other channels on the Roku have **some** free content. Please enjoy the free content and **do not attempt to purchase** any of the offered pay-per-view content.
