

Home Delivery Service

About:

The Community Library of DeWitt & Jamesville offers a free delivery service for all homebound patrons. Any resident of the library's service area who is not able to come in to the library because of a temporary or permanent disability and satisfies eligibility criteria is welcome to take advantage of this service. We also welcome new parents to call for this service.

Who is Eligible to Participate in the Home Delivery Service?

You are eligible to participate in our program if:

- 1) You live in the Community Library of DeWitt & Jamesville's service area**
- 2) You have a valid OCPL Library Card**
- 3) You meet at least one of these eligibility criteria:**
 - Senior citizen non-drivers
 - Those with long term illnesses or disabilities that do not allow them to travel to the Library
 - Those with short term illnesses or disabilities that do not allow them to travel to the Library (recovery lasting at least six weeks)
 - New parents for the first six months after childbirth

How do I apply?

- Print out, complete, and mail (or have someone drop off) the Home Delivery Application Form available at the Library or on our web site at www.cldandj.org. You may also call the Library at 446-3578 for help with registration.
- If our program enrollment is full at the time you apply, we will notify you and place you on a waiting list.

How do I select library materials?

- Once your registration is approved, one of our outreach liaisons will contact you to discuss your preferences and place requests. You can look up available materials through our online catalog at www.cldandj.org, or you can ask your liaison to help you select materials.
- **You may select up to five print materials and three media items each month.** Materials available for delivery include all CLD&J books, audiobooks, magazines, DVDs, and BluRays, with the exception of "new" items with a 3 day or 7 day loan period.
- Library staff members can provide you with instructions and guidance on how to utilize our digital services such as Hoopla and Libby for eBooks, audiobooks, and movies.

When will my items be delivered?

- Your items will be delivered on a monthly basis, on the first Thursday of every month.
- Items may be renewed, but you may not have more than five printed materials and three media items total each month.
