Summer Reading Program (SRP) Staff (Grades 8–12)

We are seeking committed and enthusiastic candidates to fulfill this vital role. Help us with the Summer Reading Program by staffing the Children’s Room desk. You will be interacting with library patrons, assisting with the reading program, helping out in the Children’s Room, and completing other tasks as assigned. Volunteers work a set schedule of 1 or 2 2 hour shifts Monday-Friday during the 8 weeks of the Summer Reading Program. Summer Reading kicks off on July 1st and runs until August 24. Note that any applicant with a scheduled summer camp, job, vacation, etc. that will cause them to miss more than 2 of their scheduled shifts will not be eligible. **Applications Due by June 11th.**

Candidates will be interviewed and are required to attend a mandatory training day before the start of the Summer Reading Program. Space is limited.
